When asked why he hasn't gone to the doctor, he replied, "I don't have the time. She's the one I worry about."

As a recipient of the *Adopt A Caregiver Program*, Del Oro is able to offer caregiver respite to help this loving spouse take time to care for himself so that he has his health and the energy he needs to continue caring for his wife.
